It is wonderful to see children growing in confidence, very lively and extremely noisy. It is almost



impossible to recognise these children as the same traumatised and neglected children that first came to join the family.



Child Sponsorship Scheme

September is a difficult month for poor agricultural farmers as food is running short and they are planning to plant new crops if the weather conditions are favourable. There was much rejoicing when 150 sponsored children each received a gift of food and extra financial support from their sponsor.





Clean water saves lives

Two more communities were blessed with clean water and no longer have to collect water from

dirty ponds. Two members of the visiting team who had raised money to provide one of the Protected Springs were present to personally meet and celebrate with the beneficiaries and officially hand over this life saving gift.





Abandoned Baby Boy

Our good working relationships with local government organisations continue to benefit many children. Advice and concerns about children are shared and we value support from each other. We received an urgent



call from the Senior Social Worker in Rukungiri asking if we could find a home for an abandoned baby boy as all attempts to trace his family had failed. Fortunately we were able to settle him with one of our new Foster Carers and he is doing well and enjoying eating, playing and being loved by her.
