The evening was dedicated to God by Rev. Joe Egan with prayer and Bible readings and the North London Singers blessed everyone throughout the evening with a wonderful programme. The BOHCM history and an overview of the current projects including Child Sponsorship, Protected Springs, Bible Based Holiday Clubs and Youth Sports Programme were shared with all.
