

## Bridge of Hope nursery and primary school

Currently we are planning to assist the children's parents to purchase "sportswear" – t-shirts and shorts. The parents requested these items and explained that it would help the children to preserve their school uniforms during games lessons. Our aim is to contribute

towards the sportswear for one class per term until the whole school has this kit. Any child on a BOHCM bursary will be fully funded.

Recently we were able to offer medical treatment to Princess, a nursery child, in order to remove a diseased eye. It has been replaced with a synthetic one and Princess has recovered well from the operation and has good vision in her healthy eye. We are now making arrangements to give the priceless gift of sight to another child, Ronald, later this year as he is in need of a cornea transplant.
