

News

The Bridge of Hope Nursery and Primary School opened its final section and successfully appointed two more teachers. We continue to offer free school meals to over 400 children.

The Bible Based Holiday Clubs hosted hundreds of children on both sites and continues to offer a holistic programme to children from age 8-17yrs.

Clean water saves lives and two more Protected Springs were officially opened in rural areas providing lifesaving clean water to hundreds of people. A further site was identified and work began to convert this to a Protected Spring.

Two children were given emergency medical treatment funded by BOHCM with one of the children requiring an operation on the same day we took her to hospital. They are now both recovering.

Another two homes were built for families, whilst others received a latrine.

We are currently planning to replace our old and faithful truck which has served us well for the past seven years.
